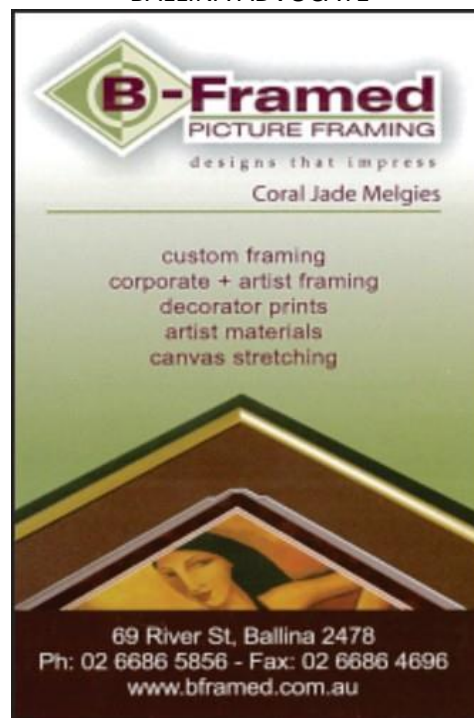

Entry fees may be paid by direct deposit into BACCI account. Details as follows: Ballina Arts and Crafts Greater Building Society BSB 637-000 A/C 780393408 - please put your name as reference on the deposit. Entries may be paid by cheque or money order. Entries may also be dropped off at Ballina copy Centre. Entry form due by Monday 19th October - **Reminder you must be a member to enter.**

Entry fees: \$5.00 per hanging work, \$20.00 per craft table (limit of one per member) \$2.00 per 10 cards

Commission: 10% on sales of artwork, no commission on craft sales

Delivery: to the Richmond Room **8.00am to 10.00am Friday 30th October** at the Richmond Room
Collection: 3.00 to 4.00pm same place (please not before, unless prior arrangement has been made)

Insurance: BACCI will take all due care but cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to artwork

Labelling: All works should be labelled clearly with artist's name, address, phone number, title, price and medium. Works to be delivered in a suitable condition for hanging with "D" rings and cords attached.

Size limit: 1.5 square metres in any configuration (outer dimensions including frame)

Conditions of entry:

- Entry Form to be received no later than 12.00 midnight **Monday 19th October 2015.**
- All entries must be for sale
- Entry fee is not refundable
- Work must be completed in the last two years and owned and created by the artist.
- Entries may be reproduced in print or media for the purpose of advertising the exhibition

Exhibition Opening Friday 30th October 6.00 pm

Exhibition Closes Sunday 1 November at 3.00 p.m.
